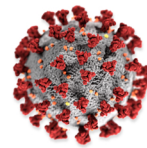

Teacher faces backlash for suggesting student pledge allegiance to Pride flag

Her California school district says it is investigating the comments, which were made in a video shared on TikTok.

A California school district is investigating a teacher who posted a now-viral video in which she joked about telling a student that he could pledge allegiance to the Pride flag.

In the video, Kristin Pitzer, who teaches English as a second language for the Newport-Mesa Unified School District, about 40 miles south of Los Angeles, talks about how she allows students to say the Pledge of Allegiance in her classroom.

"OK, so during third period, we do announcements and they do the Pledge of Allegiance," Pitzer said in the video shared to her TikTok account, @mrsgillingsworth, which has been deleted. "I always tell my class, 'Stand if you feel like it, don't stand if you feel like it, say the words if you want. You don't have to say the words.' So my class decided to stand but not say the words. Totally fine. Except for the fact that my room does not have a flag."

Pitzer pointed to where the American flag used to be in her classroom, but said she took it out during the Covid-19 pandemic "because it made me uncomfortable," she whispered. She said she packed it away and hasn't found it yet.

School forced to fork over \$1.3 million for not allowing trans student to use preferred bathroom

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(THE BLAZE) - A Virginia school board will pay more than \$1.3 million to the American Civil Liberties Union after losing a court battle involving a transgender student who sued the school over its bathroom policy.

According to the Virginian-Pilot, the Gloucester County School Board on Thursday agreed to pay the ACLU the full amount of costs and fees associated with its representation of one of its former students, Gavin Grimm, marking the end of a lengthy six-year legal fight.

Schröder faces growing scandal over job with Russian gas giant

Germany's former chancellor Gerhard Schröder was yesterday at the centre of damaging allegations of sleaze over his decision to accept a lucrative job with Russia's biggest company.

Opposition MPs joined forces to denounce Mr Schröder - who last week confirmed that he was to become chairman of state-controlled Russian giant Gazprom's North European Gas Pipeline company. Mr Schröder was accused of bringing German politics into disrepute and of "cronyism" and "corruption".

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Russia and Germany sign gas deal

Germany and Russia have signed a pipeline agreement on Thursday that will bypass the current energy network and transport gas under the Baltic Sea.

Russian President Vladimir Putin and Chancellor Gerhard Schröder finalised the deal, worth some \$5bn (£2.7bn).

Russia's Gazprom will own 51% of the pipeline, with Germany's E.ON and BASF taking 24.5% each.

The pipeline has not been without controversy, and Poland has complained it may compromise its own supplies.

The pipeline will link the Russian port of Wyborg and the town of Greifswald in north-eastern Germany, running underwater for almost 1,200 kilometres (744 miles).
