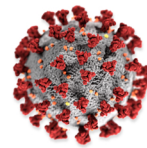


MEDIA = VIRUS

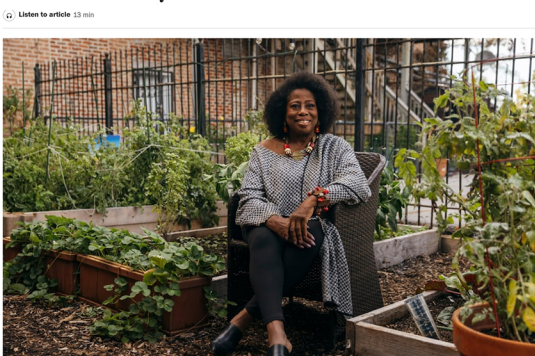

CHICAGO — Standing on the rear third-floor deck of the Blacks in Green building on South Cottage Grove Avenue, Naomi Davis and Stacey McVaine looked out over the desert that is West Woodlawn.

Davis, an environmental activist, and McVaine, an electrician, had come together on a gray fall day to discuss how they could correct a complete absence of electric vehicle chargers in one of Chicago's preeminent Black neighborhoods.
