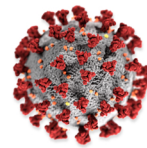

Ninety-seven percent of scientists agree: Climate change is real, man-made and dangerous. 97% of scientists are in agreement is stated as an undisputable fact. It's based on a survey done by **John Cook**, Climate Communications Fellow for the Global Change Institute & his colleagues, published in the journal *Environmental Research Letters* in May, 2013
