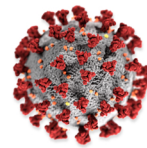


MEDIA = VIRUS

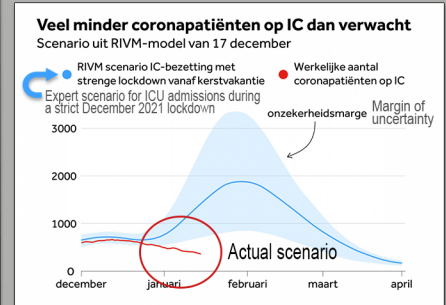
Head of UK Health Security Agency warns MPs to expect 'staggering' growth rate in coming days

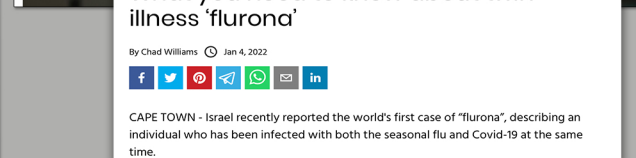
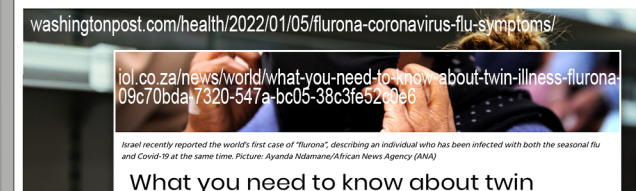
