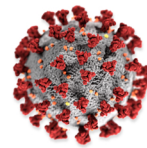

US man turns down a life-saving kidney transplant over his hospital's vaccination policy

An unvaccinated North Carolina man turned down a life-saving kidney transplant over a hospital's vaccination policy, telling WSOC he will "die free."

Chad Carswell, who is a double amputee and has undergone major

He said doctors at Atrium Health Wake Forest Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem told him that he needed a kidney transplant to live.

But the hospital said that in order to receive the surgery, Carswell and his donor must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19, WSOC reported.

Carswell decided to turn down the surgery instead, telling WSOC: "I was born free. I will die free. I'm not changing my mind."

A Boston hospital is defending itself after a man's family claimed he was denied a new heart for refusing to be vaccinated against COVID-19, saying most transplant programs around the country set similar requirements to improve patients' chances of survival.

The family of D.J. Ferguson said in a crowdfunding appeal this week that officials at Brigham and Women's Hospital told the 31-year-old father of two that he was ineligible for the procedure because he hasn't been vaccinated against the coronavirus.

"We are literally in a corner right now. This is extremely time sensitive," the family said in its fundraising appeal, which has raised tens of thousands of dollars. "This is not just a political issue. People need to be heard."

Sounds like he was referring to Covid restrictions.

Ottawa Mayor Jim Watson fumed over what he called "threatening" behaviour by some of the protesters, particularly against the media.

"Stop the bully tactics and show some respect to fellow Canadians," he said on Twitter.

Later, in an interview with the CBC, Watson said it was time for protesters to "move on" so Ottawa can return to normal.

"Quite frankly, (residents) feel they're prisoners in their own home," he said.

How many dozens in real numbers? Thousands!

The protest originated last week in western Canada, where dozens of truckers organized a convoy to drive from Vancouver to the Canadian capital to demonstrate against Covid-related restrictions, particularly a recent vaccination requirement for truck drivers crossing the long US-Canada border.

50,000 trucks heading toward Ottawa to demand an end to COVID mandates

"Freedom Convoy 2022," which began rolling east from western Canada over the weekend, has turned into a grassroots movement in Canada.

(LifeSiteNews) - Thousands of Canadian truckers began a "slow roll" to Ottawa this weekend to protest draconian COVID job mandates and other virus rules imposed by Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and provincial premiers.

The "Freedom Convoy 2022" group raised \$3.5 million in only 11 days, seeing grassroots support for Canadian truckers against both a COVID job mandate for all haulers crossing the border and all other virus rules increase at an astonishingly rapid pace.

According to the "Freedom Convoy 2022" Go Fund Me page, the group has support from more than 44,000 donors who are helping fund the convoy, which, once in Ottawa, plans to stay there until political leaders remove all discriminatory COVID measures. "We are taking our fight to the doorstep of our Federal Government and demanding that they cease all mandates against its people. Small businesses are being destroyed, homes are being destroyed, and people are being mistreated and denied fundamental necessities to survive," reads the "Freedom Convoy 2022" Go Fund Me page.

The funds raised will go toward the cost of "fuel, food and lodgings to help ease the pressures of this arduous task."

Over the weekend, truckers and their supporters from western Canada began their caravan, starting from cities and towns in British Columbia, with thousands of Alberta truck drivers joining yesterday.

Some estimates put the total amount of truckers who will take part in the caravan at well over 50,000 trucks and more than half a million people.

The trucker caravan from the Edmonton, Alberta, area alone yesterday was said to be more than 40 kilometers in length before arriving in Calgary to head east to Ottawa.

From British Columbia, estimates put their caravan, who have now joined up in Alberta on their way east, at well over 70 kilometers in length.

By comparison, Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's reigning Liberal Party of Canada raked in \$3.7 million during the last quarter of 2021, according to public records with Elections Canada. The opposing Conservative Party of Canada collected a little more than \$3 million during the same period.

Among the other parties represented in the Canadian House of Commons, the New Democratic Party raised \$1.8 million, the Green Party of Canada raised about \$800,000, and Bloc Québécois raised a little more than \$150,000.

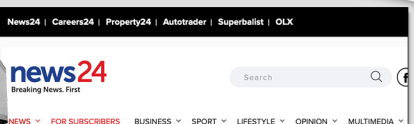
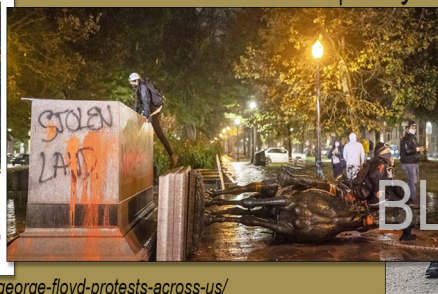

Canada rally against mandates blocks capital

Hundreds of protesters gathered in Ottawa on Sunday, a day after thousands descended on Canada's capital city to protest against Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and COVID-19 vaccine mandates.

On the second day of Canada's vaccine mandates protest, thousands of demonstrators along with a "Freedom Convoy" of trucks brought Ottawa to a virtual halt.

The chaos clogged the capital's downtown near parliament throughout the weekend and brought criticism from officials including Ottawa's mayor.

Protesters threatened to disrupt business on Monday, with authorities stating that City Hall will remain closed, traffic will be disrupted and some other services stalled.

A "Freedom Convoy" of trucks joined by thousands of demonstrators brought Ottawa to a virtual standstill for a second day on Sunday to protest Canada's vaccine mandates, as other sympathetic truckers blocked a border highway into the United States.

Trudeau slammed the convoy as being composed of a "small fringe minority" of people who hold "unacceptable views."
